

## MENTOR MENTEE ACADEMIC AGREEMENT

## Between

St. Anne's College of Engineering and Technology, Cuddalore, Tamilnadu

and

CHRIST (Deemed to be University), Bengaluru, India

**Whereas** St. Anne's College of Engineering and Technology, ...(hereinafter referred to as "Mentee")

Whereas CHRIST (Deemed to be University), a Higher Education Institution declared under Section 3 of the UGC Act 1956, and NAAC Accredited, offering multi-disciplinary undergraduate, postgraduate and Research Programmes established in 1969 with the motto of "Excellence and Service" located at Hosur Road, Bangalore 560029 particularly for its NBA Accredited, School of Engineering and Technology located at Bengaluru Kengeri Campus, Kanmanike, Kumbalgodu, Mysore Road, Bangalore, Karnataka - 560074 (hereinafter referred as "Mentor") through its Industry Institute Interaction Cell (hereinafter referred to as "CU-IIIC")

Whereas as Mentor and Mentee (hereinafter jointly referred to as 'Parties') have agreed to enter into collaboration for mutual benefit to the constituent stakeholders, particularly for the students, faculty and any other stakeholders of the Parties.

## This Academic Agreement is entered into between the Parties this..... day of .......... 2023 which witnessed as hereunder.

- 1. The purpose of this Agreement is to build friendship and goodwill and foster a relationship that will promote mutual intellectual exchanges between students, faculty members and other stakeholders of School of Engineering and Technology, CHRIST (Deemed to be University) and St. Anne's College of Engineering and Technology, Cuddalore, Tamilnadu
- 2. In an effort to experience the lifelong learning process, both parties are prepared to participate in a formal exchange programme that seeks to promote a mutually beneficial academic exchange.
- 3. The collaboration will be on the following fronts:
  - a) Students and faculty mentoring and exchange
  - b) Joint Workshops, seminars and Faculty Development programmes
  - c) Research facilities support for students and staff of mentee
  - d) Innovation and training with a focus developing Incubation and entrepreneurship activities
  - e) Joint research proposal and paper publications



- f) Promoting Science and Innovation Club Exhibition in both the campus.
- g) Possibility of CU offering lectures/session on field practice, service learning, EEP for Mentee by Mentor
- 4. Both parties are responsible for their own costs in relation to this Agreement unless otherwise mutually agreed. Mentor and Mentee affirm this Agreement by the signature of their officials duly authorise to enter into and to implement the same.
- 5. This Agreement will become effective from the date herein mentioned above and shall remain valid for a period of **Two** (2) Years unless either Party terminates the same on three months' prior notice to the other. Notwithstanding any such termination, any programme that is being implemented under Clause 3 above shall continue till its full completion
- 6. This Agreement shall be reviewed at the end of the first year for the progress made and may be modified if required. At least three months prior to the expiry of the tenure, the agreement shall be assessed for its overall performance and subject to mutual consensus; it may be renewed on such terms and conditions as may be mutually agreeable.
- 7. Each party shall have a coordinator for the agreement who shall be responsible for organising and implementing this agreement under Clause 3. The contact details of the coordinators shall be stated herein and may be changed by the parties at any time during the term of this Agreement, through written communication.
