

#### iii) Dengue and Corona health awareness

On 17.12.2021, the Chief Guest, Mr. Bharathi, Health Analyst, Medical Team, Oraiyur, gave a valuable talk on "Dengue and Corona health awareness". He said that Dengue fever is a mosquito-borne tropical disease caused by the dengue virus. Symptoms typically begin three to fourteen days after infection. These may include a high fever, headache, vomiting, muscle and joint pain, and a characteristic skin rash. Recovery generally takes two to seven days. He suggested to use insect repellent, wear long-sleeved shirts and long pants, and control mosquitoes inside and outside the home to protect against dengue mosquito bites. He also advised about the precautions to prevent the spread of COVID-19 by maintaining hygiene and washing hands frequently, especially if travelled by public transport then use an alcohol sanitizer and wearing a mask (cover the nose and mouth). Finally, our NSS Volunteers undertook a rally on "Dengue Awareness".
