- The teachers participate in various seminars and present research papers and also provide training in other colleges.

- National Service Scheme of both the colleges have conducted many social awareness programs like Blood Donation Camp, Anti-Drug Awareness, Fire Prevention Regulations, Anti-Ragging Awareness, Ground Water Conservation, Palm Seed Planting Event, Voter Awareness etc, and students motivated to work for the welfare of society through NSS programmes.

- Both the colleges benefit from MoUs with industries in various sectors.

- By Naan Mudhalvan Scheme, the institutions provided professional knowledge and financial assistance to outstanding works of the students.

- Needed awareness and financial supports for studying children are given to the Irular community people living around the college are also served in times of need.

- In both the colleges, a project exhibition was conducted to bring the technical knowledge of the students into practice and arrangements were made to visit the surrounding government and private schools.

- The necessary document preparation and audit are done in all departments of Annai Velankanni Polytechnic to get the NBA standard certificate.

- Tamil Nadu State Council of Science and Technology and Annai Velankanni Polytechnic College organized a Science and Technology Skill Development Program where the best professionals were invited and the students were given training along with encouragement. Cuddalore and Villupuram area students were participated and benefited.

- An engineering college student got the opportunity to directly participate in the Global Investors Meet 2024 seminar chaired by the Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu through his best work.

Parent Teacher meeting, Alumni Association meeting, Sports Festival, Women's Day etc. are conducted very well. And also, Independence Day, Republic Day, Teacher's Day, Diwali, Pongal Thirunal, Ayudha Pooja, St. Annal Suvaikin

- The graduation ceremony in both the colleges is conducted in an elegant manner.
- Students who are economically backward due to family circumstances are given special concessions in both the colleges in terms of tuition fees, bus fees and hostel fees to continue their education.
- Technical college is working specially to get scholarship and other assistance for the students from the government through schemes like SC ST scholarship, Pudhumai pen, Pragati Scheme and swanthan scheme.
- In engineering college, arrangements are made to get scholarship from Government schemes like First Graduate, SC ST Minority and pudumai pen in order to help the students.
