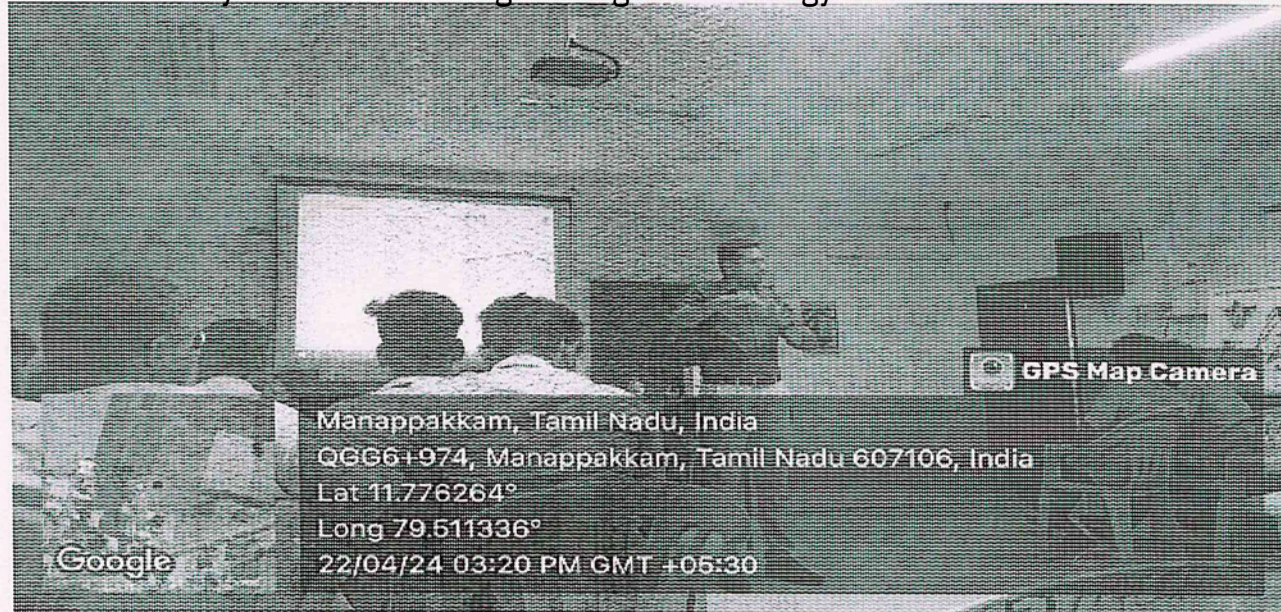
REPORT OF THE PROGRAM
