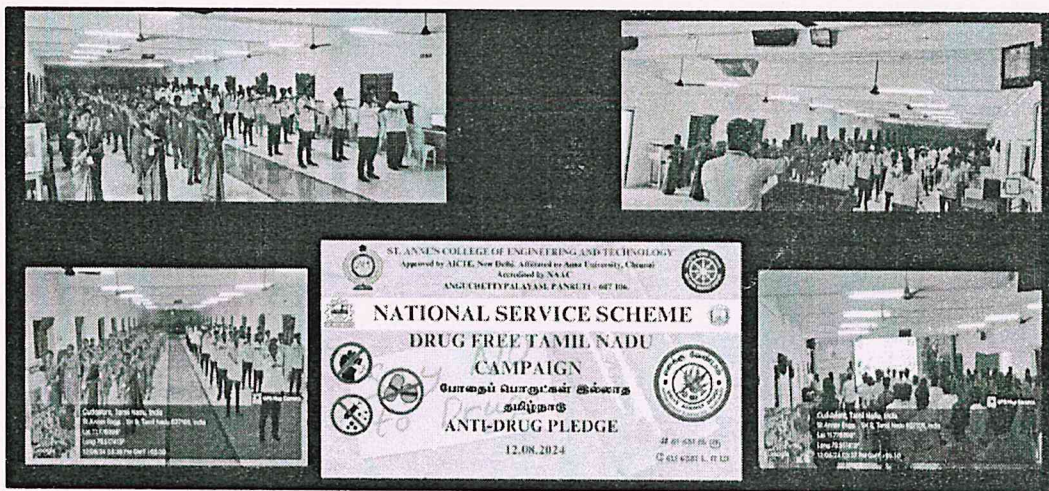
## DRUG FREE TAMIL NADU CAMPAIGN REPORT

## INDEPENDENCE DAY CELEBRATION

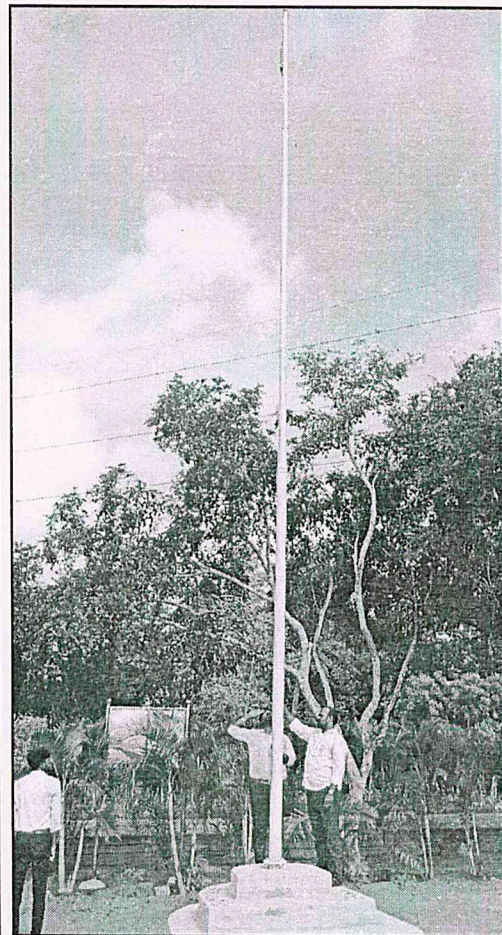

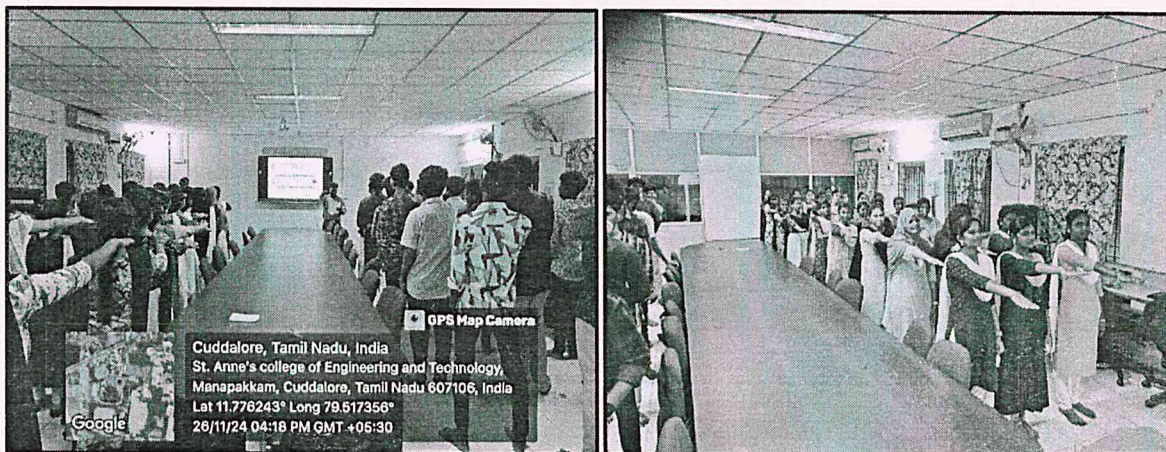
## CONSTITUTION DAY- PLEDGE REPORT

## INTERNATIONAL YOGA DAY 2025

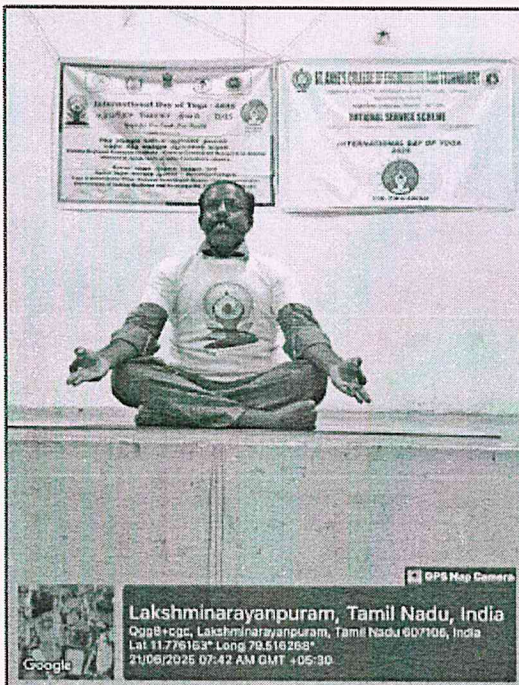
