
PLACE: Anguchettypalayam village

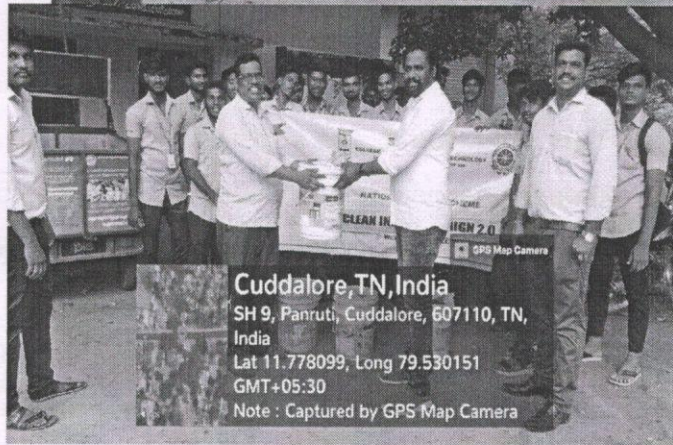
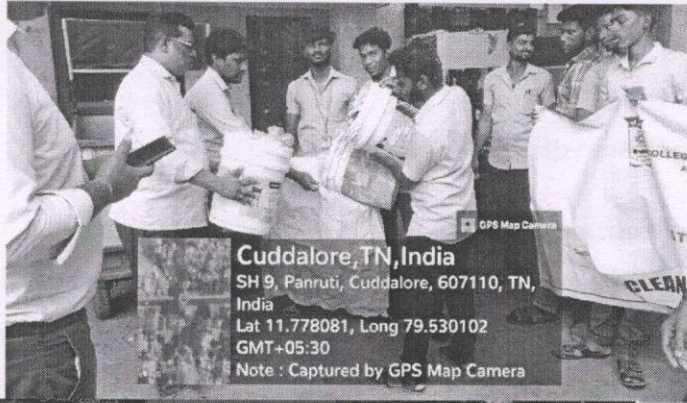
